CROSS COUNTRY/SNOWSHOE DAY TRIPS SKI BUSES

Throughout the winter season we go on midweek and weekend ski trips. Starting in January these trips will run every Saturday, Sunday, Thursday and Friday. The group goes by charter bus which picks up members from several locations in the Seattle, Everett, Bellevue, and Federal Way areas. The buses take us to different locations in the Cascade Mountains to ski and snowshoe their roads and trails. Destinations include such areas as: Greenwater, Keechelus Ridge, Cabin Creek, Tonga Ridge, and many others. Once there the bus becomes our lodge, providing warmth and shelter during the day.

A series of ski trips will take us to a different destination each week, providing a constant variety. Each series includes a lesson, and five trips which run every other weekend for ten weeks. Many members prefer to go every weekend, and do this by requesting two series which intermesh. Trail maps are provided for each destination. The maps include information about the distance, elevation gain and difficulty of the many possible tours.
